

Pilsnere / Lyse lagerøl

Det var tydelig at se på tilmeldingen at smagningerne var savnet efter denne lille jule pause, for hele 20 medlemmer havde fået tilmeldt sig.

Og det var hyggeligt at mødes med gamle kendinge men bestemt også dejligt at se helt nye ansigter.

Aften forløb med at Peter fortalt en lille smugle om pilsner, hvorefter vi smagte os gennem 12 øl. Undervejs i smagning blev der untappe en del, samt talt meget om de forskellige øl. Der var bred enighed om at de danske bud der var taget med var ikke de bedste af aftenens øl. Dog var der delte meninger om hvilke øl der skulle være aftenens bedste. Men det er jo også det der gøre verden så dejligt at folk har så mange forskellige smage og holdninger til hvad der er en god øl.

Liste over de øl aften bød på

Birra Morena Classica 4,6%

Brassy gold pour. Large frothy white head. Sweet bready malt aroma. Thin bodied, grainy malt flavor. Refreshing, but otherwise lacking in flavor. Some lemony notes in the brief dry finish.

Nørrebro Pilsner 4,6%

Medium high fluffy white lasting head. Clear yellow golden body. Weak straw flowery aroma with notes of citrus. Highly carbonated grass straw flavour with little hops bitterness and a short finish.

Brooklyn Pilsner 5,0%

Crisp and clean with a sweetish malty aroma and taste, straw, hay, cereal, light lemony note, grassy and light floral hops, medium to light bodied, balanced light bitter hoppy finish.

Mikkeller Japanese Rice Lager 5,1%

Clear, golden yellow with a medium large, foamy, almost stable, white head. Sweetish, gently fruity-floral aroma of lemon peel, pineapple and some grains with a touch of hay. Gently sweet, moderately bitter, rather fruity-floral and slightly grassy taste of grains, lemon peel, pineapple and some hay, followed by a short, gently bitter, slightly dry finish. Medium body, smooth and slightly effervescent mouthfeel, average carbonation. Refreshing, well-balanced lager, fairly quaffable.

To Øl 45 Days Rice Lager 5,0%

Appearance: pours clear golden with ok soapy white head and lacing. Aroma/taste: barley, bread, straw and light grassy notes. Palette: medium malty aroma, average carbonation, low to medium body, medium sweetness, somewhat balanced by a light to medium bitterness, average duration, light sweet finish and a watery texture.

Schönramer Pils 5,0%

Clear, golden with a medium large, foamy, almost stable, white head. Slightly sweetish, moderately grassy-spicy, a little fruity-floral aroma of lemon peel, some fresh grass and a touch of grains.

Moderately sweet, slightly bitter, gently fruity-floral and a bit grassy-spicy taste of grains, lemon peel and some fresh grass, followed by a short, gently bitter, slightly dry finish. Medium body, smooth and gently effervescent mouthfeel, soft carbonation. Very well-brewed Pils, quite smooth and nicely aromatic.

Krusovice Bohem 4,7%

Aroma; yellow apple, bread, leaves, meadow, caramel malts. Look; dense off white head, clear deep golden body, dense carpet lacing. Taste; strawy hops, apple peel, meadow, leaves, bread, caramel malts and balanced. Feel; normal body and well carbonated.

Siberia Bozi Lezak 5,3%

Pours almost clear pale yellow with a huge white head. A bit bubbly. Settles as thin, almost transparent layer of foam stretching to cover the surface of the beer. Substantial lacing. Aroma is medium intense with a sweet odor of pale malts mingling with fresh grass and a bit of citrus. Bread and straws. Whiff of citrus fruit. Fresh. Light carbonation. Thin, oily, soft, almost flat texture. Flavor is medium intense with a medium strong sweetness followed by a slightly stronger bitterness.

Aftertaste is bitter with a sweet undertone. Lingers for a bit. Finish is dry.

Põhjala Laager 4,7%

Clear yellow-golden color with foamy white head. Aroma of grain, grass and malts with some mild citrus notes. Taste is crispy with hops, grass and malts. Finishes mild bitter. Full body, average carbonation. Lager with some hop character.

Alefarm Aya (Modern Pilsner) 4,6%

An unclear dark golden beer with a lacing beige head. The aroma has notes of exotic fruits, spices, hops, and malt. The flavor is sweet with notes of exotic fruits, lemons, hops, spices, and malt, leading to a bitter finish.

Slowburn Octopils 5,1%

Hazy yellowish golden color with a small foamy white head, which leaves some lace. Aroma is grainy, some sweet malts, citrus and some mild wooden and citrus tones.

The flavor is sweet floral tones, some sweet malts and grains with some citrus and mild herbal tones. Quite crisp finish.

Sessionable "modern" kind of Pilsner.

Siberia / Les Intenables Kill The Saaz (collab) 6,6%

Almost clear, gold, medium white head. Floral aroma, almonds, lime. Taste is dry, moderately bitter with strongly bitter finish, orange, noble hops, almonds, strawberry candies, lime, intense fresh hop character, malts. Fuller body, average carbonation.
